The Edina Early Learning Center educational offerings are here for your family as soon as you welcome baby. Our programs fall into four categories, described below.

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)

- Unique to Minnesota, ECFE classes provide opportunites for children and parents to learn and grow together.
- Parent education is provided either separate from children or together, depending on age and family choice.
- ECFE classes are offered from birth to 5 years, with many options to fit your schedule!

Preschool Classes

- These classes nurture and expand your child's next step in their educational development.
- We provide a variety of schedules to fit families's needs.
- In addition to preschool, we offer childcare and enrichment classes to round out the day if desired.

Parent Education

- We offer many classes for parents and children together, such as baby massage, baby sign language, and more!
- Parent-only classes help you navigate the ups and downs of the first few years of your life as a family, while sharing experiences with other parents.

ELC Teachers: Building Relationships and Community

Creating Welcoming Spaces

As young children take the first steps into Edina Schools, teachers like Alaina Zapata ensure a safe and welcoming space for them.

Alaina has worked at the Early Learning Center for seven years and has taught all ages of preschoolers.

"This place has helped me to grow into who I am and the teacher I never dreamed I could be." she says.

Alaina knows how impactful the relationships made in the classroom can be, not only for the children but for the families as well.

"I recognize that theses students are coming from different walks of life and home lives as they come together to create that classroom community and family," Alania describes.

"This is where you start, where you learn how to be a kind human being and to build friendships," Alaina continues.

Alaina and all our teachers strive to set their students up for success before they enter elementary school, using a teaching tool called the Pyramid Model. This model is a framework of evidence-based practices for promoting young children's healthy social and emotional development.

"I want my students to leave here knowing that they were loved and that they belonged and that they had a sense of place in my classroom," Alaina concludes. "What matters most is that they know that they have a place in this world and that being a kind human being is the only thing that matters." Raising children is an important and sometimes challenging role and having a committed and caring community can really help. The Early Learning Center (ELC) provides that community with supportive and caring teachers that are committed to ensuring the youngest learners and their families are supported and welcomed into Edina Schools.

Making Connections Inside and Outside the Classroom

The ELC's supportive and caring Parent Educators include Linda Stotts and Deb Roberts who have taught for more than 25 years combined in the Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) and Parent Education classes. Their expertise ranges from birth to adolescence as they help parents learn more about their children, how to meet their needs, and help parents to get to know each other and build community.

"Parenting is the hardest job most of us will ever have. Children don't come with an instruction manual, and each child has unique needs," Deb explains. "Good parenting requires constant reflection, adjustment, creativity and continuing education and support. We offer parents those tools."

Our Parent Educators understand that everyone brings different experiences and situations to class and strive to support families as they come together to make connections, and to learn and grow from each other.

Linda Stotts describes, "When you have a class of 12 people, they do a lot of teaching amongst themselves as far as giving great direction and ideas for what works for them." Those family connection are a reason why our programs are important – they bring parents together to create a circle of support and understanding between people who are sharing experiences. And these relationships often extend beyond the classroom. Linda herself is proof of the lifelong friendships that can come from time together in ECFE.

"I was in an ECFE group with my twins who are now 23 and those women I met are just incredible people in my life because they were there when it was really hard," Linda says.

Whether you are a new parent to the district or newly welcoming a child into your life and family, our doors are always open to start meeting people who are on the same path as you and want to support each other.

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)



"All Caregivers are Welcome!"

While we use the word "parent", we recognize that not all family structures look the same. Any and all adults parenting and/ or caregiving are welcome in our classes. Our hallmark program for infants, toddlers and their parents is called "Early Childhood Family Education" or "ECFE." Unique to Minnesota and supported by the legislature, ECFE has been supporting and strengthening families since 1973.

ECFE classes help you develop a new appreciation of the world from your child's perspective, a growing support network of parents on a shared journey, and a shared sense of purpose as you connect with others who want to make a difference and build community.

Here's a preview of what you and your child will experience in ECFE

Parent-Child Activity Time

You and your child enjoy time together with developmentally-appropriate activities.

Parent Discussion

Join other parents and a licensed Parent Educator to discuss the joys and challenges of parenting while learning effective, researchbased parenting strategies.

Children's Learning Time

In classes where children and parents separate for the parent discussion, children will stay with licensed early childhood teachers. Children develop social-emotional skills while playing and learning with others.

Separating/Non-Separating

Most ECFE classes for the very youngest children have the parent education component within the classroom, so babies and caregivers stay together. These are our "non-separating" classes. As children get ready for more independence, they remain in their space while parents convene in a separate room for parent education. These are our "separating" classes.

Sibling Care

Sibling care is available while you are attending an ECFE class with your infant/toddler. In sibling care, children ages 6 weeks through pre-K spend time in age-appropriate exploration, play and activities under the supervision of our highly-trained, dedicated staff. Sibling care is available for all ECFE classes offered between 8:30am and 3:30pm, Monday through Friday. Sibling care is not available for evening or weekend classes. Register for sibling care when you register for your family education class.

Using The Creative Curriculum[®], we also provide opportunities to help them develop healthy social skills and learn to advocate appropriately for their needs.

A Day in the Life of a Preschooler:

Circle Time/Morning Meeting: We start our day building strong community through songs, read-alouds, stories and calendar. Teachers model social and emotional skills, including creating and maintaining friendships.

Literacy: Students will build concepts about print, comprehension and some basic letter and sound practice.

Math: Students work on number sense, patterning, colors/shapes and other emergent math concepts.

Science: Science is all around us and students will learn how to explore, question and discover through scientific themes like nature, plants, animals, ecosystems and weather.

Choice Time/Gym/Creative Movement:

Self-directed learning is imperative to a child's development, so we provide many opportunities for free play and large motor play.

Art, Music and Theater: Learning in preschool happens through an artistic, musical lens. We love to sing, dance and act out our learning!

Childcare for Preschoolers

Do you need a little extra care for your child before or after preschool? We've created a flexible option just for you! Your child will be escorted by classroom staff to/from the childcare space when you add this option to your weekly schedule. Children enrolled in childcare enjoy a variety of age-appropriate academic and play-based activities. Daily activities are planned with an enrichment focus. Students enjoy playground/gym time, creative art projects, circle time, and selfdirected play. Quiet body time occurs each afternoon.

Children must be registered for an Early Learning Center preschool class to be eligible

Childcare follows the Early Learning calendar, so when school is not in session, childcare is closed.

Enrichment Classes for Preschoolers

Students will learn about the 4 parts of STEM. Activities will focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

Early Childhood Screening

Early childhood years from birth to start of kindergarten are an important time of rapid growth. Early Childhood Screening is a quick and simple check of how your child is growing and developing. It is required by the state of Minnesota to be completed before starting kindergarten, and it is a FREE service that usually takes about an hour to complete.

At your child's screening, a trained professional will check the following:

- Vision AND hearing
- Height and weight
- Immunization review
- Large and small muscles/motor skills
- Thinking, language, and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
